## Location

Getting to and from the Copenhagen Airport  
The **metro**, conveniently located at the end of the airport arrival hall, departs every four minutes, swiftly connecting passengers to Kongens Nytorv or Nørreport in Copenhagen city center within 15 minutes.

Alternatively, the regular **train**, situated on the lower level of the arrival hall, provides quick access to Copenhagen Central, Nørreport, or Østerport, also within a 15-minute journey.

- [Reffen](#) is an organic street food market and urban area for start-ups, innovation and creativity in Refshaleøen in Copenhagen.
- [Strøget](#), Copenhagen's largest shopping area, spans 1.1km and is a bustling pedestrian street at the heart of the city.
- The [Danish Architecture Center](#) , situated at [BLOX](#) on Copenhagen harbourside, delves into urban development and architecture through engaging exhibitions, city walks, and lectures

## Good to know

- Denmark utilizes Danish Kroner (DKK) as its **currency**. Credit/debit cards, whether physical or on smartphones, are the preferred mode of payment, and some vendors may not accept cash.
- You will have to buy a ticket before boarding **public transport**. Trains, metro, and buses (including waterbuses) can all be accessed with the same ticket. Be aware of how many zones you will pass on your journey.

How to get there

*From Copenhagen Airport*

Take the train direct from Copenhagen Airport Terminal 3 on track 2 to Copenhagen. Get off at Copenhagen Central Station and walk to the Tivoli hotel, which is within 8-10 minutes walking distance.

*From Central Station*

Take the train to Dybbølsbro Station. The Tivoli hotel is located 5 minutes' walk from the station. Alternatively, take the no. 30 bus from Central Station to Fisketorvet Shopping Center.

*By taxi*

Taking a taxi from the airport will cost approx. DKK 280. All taxis are metered and accept all major international credit cards.

*Plan your journey*

Lumbye Auditorium

The auditorium is located in the basement of the Congress Centre.

How to get there

*By bus or train*

Several busses cross or pass the campus area and Lyngby Station is just 2 km away with even more bus connections. DTU campus can be easily reached from Nørreport Station via bus and/or S-train. From Nørreport take the line 15E or 150S, get off at stop Rævehøjvej DTU. Travel times are usually between 30 to 40 minutes.

Routes by train and bus: line A or E up to Lyngby Station, then bus lines 181 or 190, bus stop Lyngby Handelsskole U/NORD, or 300S bus stop DTU Rævehøjvej.

*By taxi or car*

From the airport it will cost you about DKK 600 (EUR 80) and from downtown Copenhagen about DKK 350 (EUR 47). If you arrive by car, you find free parking in front of the Oticon Hall.

*From DTU to the Copenhagen Airport*

Go to Rævehøjvej and take bus line 15E or 150S to Nørreport Station. At Nørreport take metro line M2 to Copenhagen Airport.
