ASPIS Outcomes

The final ASPIS Open Symposium 2026 brought together scientists, regulators, industry representatives, policymakers and early-stage researchers to explore how ASPIS results can support advancing the safety assessment of chemicals without the use of animal testing. The programme showcased the work of the three European Union's Horizon 2020-funded projects: **ONTOX**, **PrecisionTox**, **RISK-HUNT3R**, forming the ASPIS cluster and was structured around three thematic sessions: NGRA and regulatory relevance, research and innovation, and impact and sustainability.
